

Proposed Changes to the AIC Road Haulage Code of Practice to achieve EN 45011 Accreditation : re issue 16 June 2004

General

The Code of Practice has been produced to EN 45011 requirements include elements of 'Good Practice' and has endeavoured to make the document more user friendly through logical steps, bullet points etc.

Main Changes

- References to UKASTA have been replaced by AIC
- Clarification of the use of Vehicles/Trailers Section **C5**
- Insurance details are clarified in Section **F**
- Requirement to Audit Subcontractors/Owner Drivers annually Section **I**
- Section **M** summarises the records that must be kept.
- New Sections to meet EN 45011 requirements are introduced:
 - P** Procedures and Instructions
 - Q** Complaints Procedure
- Section **R** reflects the risks of carrying Packaged Goods and the controls required when packages are damaged.
- Although the Exclusion and Sensitive Lists have not been completed reviewed the Packaged Goods section now only includes Radioactive Materials
