

**Changes to the Code of Practice for the Storage of Combinable Crops
and Animal Feed Materials : Scheme Year 01 July 2004 – 30 June 2005**

General

The main change has been the introduction of HACCP principles to control risks during the storage process.

The Code has maintained the inclusion of Animal Feed as well as Combinable Crops although the GAFTA element is not currently part of the EN 45011 accreditation process.

The Code of Practice has been produced to include elements of 'Good Practice' and has tried to make the document more user friendly through logical steps, bullet points etc.

Main Changes

- References to UKASTA have been replaced by AIC
- HACCP principles are outlined in Section C
- Insurance details are clarified in Section G
- Drying, Cleaning, Conditioning and Blending are described in Section H 29 & H 30
- Sampling & Laboratory Analysis outlined in Section I
- Addition of specific sections as follows
